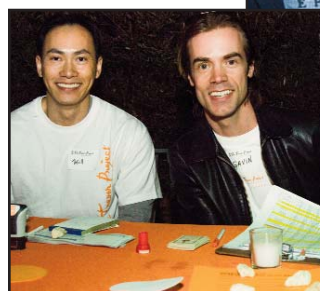

The Trevor Project held its Spring Training Class at the office of the California Federation of Teachers in Burbank during March. Counselor trainees went through 32 hours of rigorous classroom training and listened in on 10 hours of Trevor calls before taking their first call. We are pleased to announce that we graduated 22 volunteer counselors; congratulations and thank you for your dedication. Our new class of counselors brings our total number of counselors to 58, allowing the LA Call Center to expand shifts to include 3 counselors to better manage the volume of calls we receive.

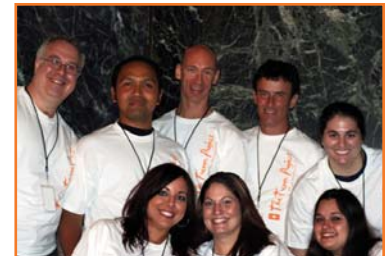
Honoree Nathan Lane
