



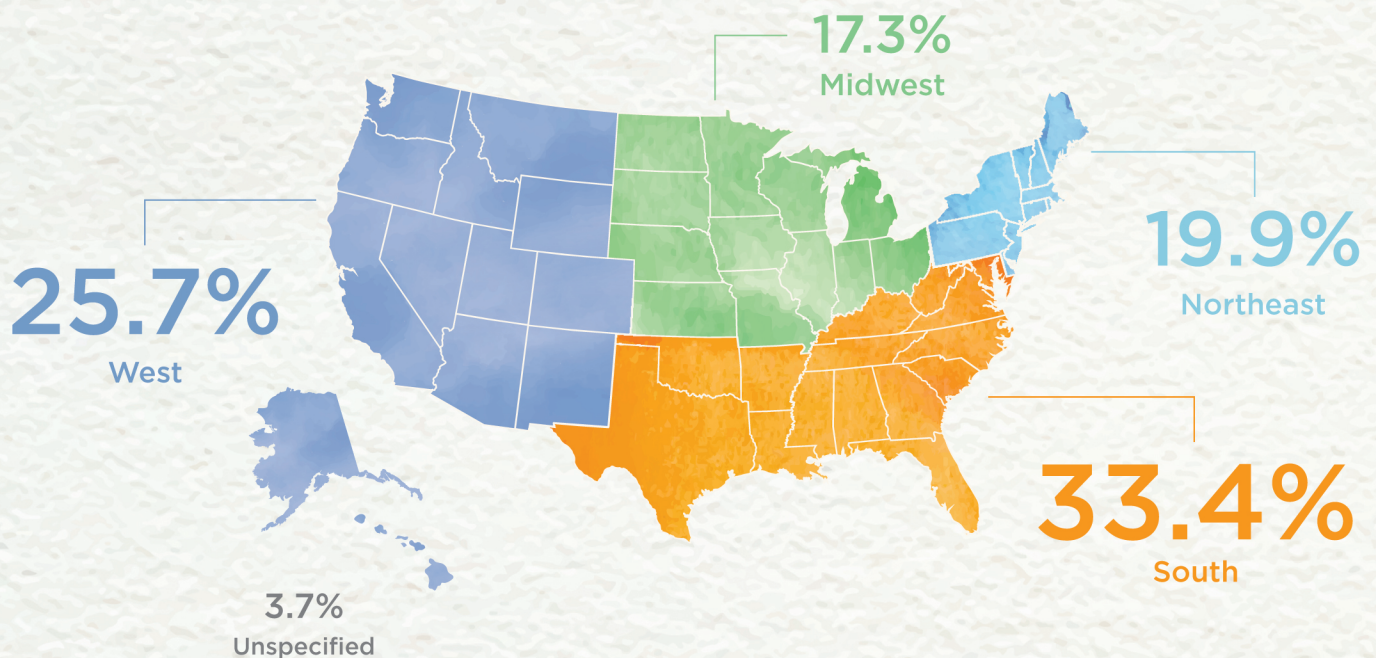

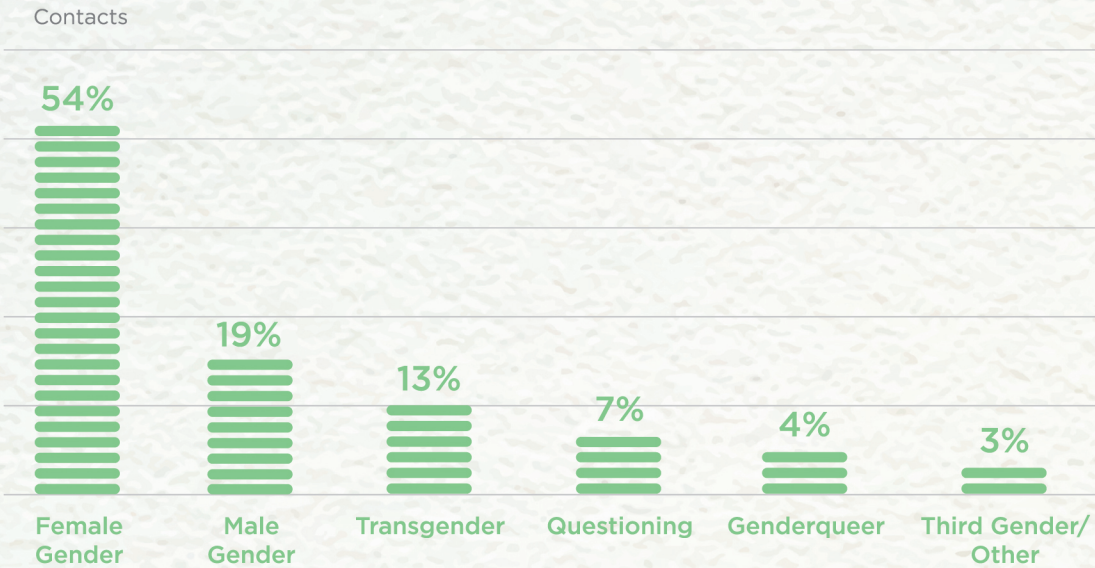

PERCENTAGE OF CRISIS CONTACTS BY REGION

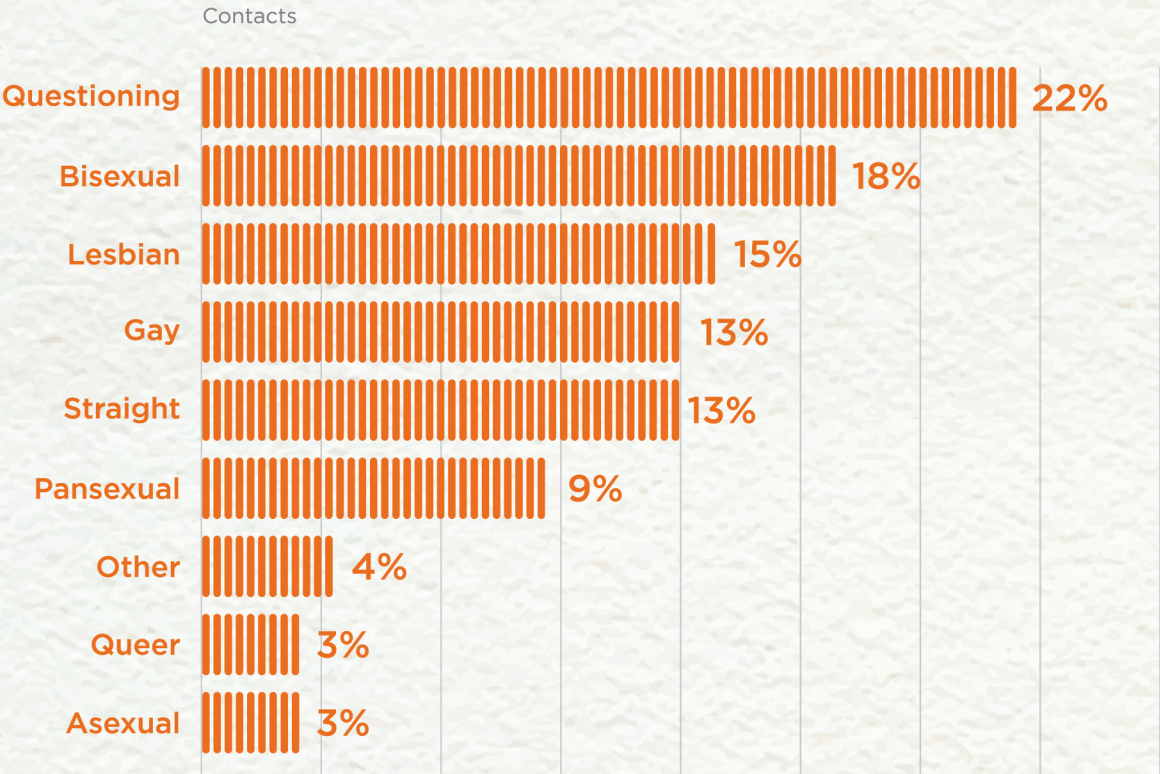


GENDERS SERVED BY TREVORCHAT AND TREVORTEXT

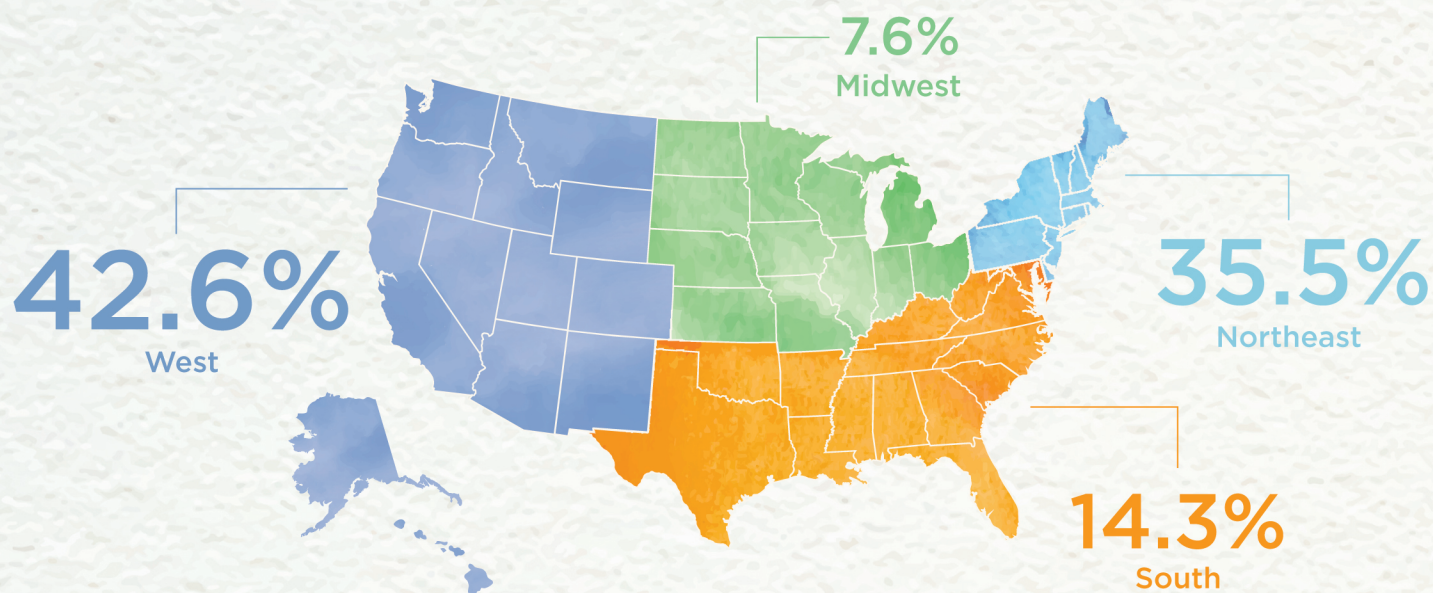

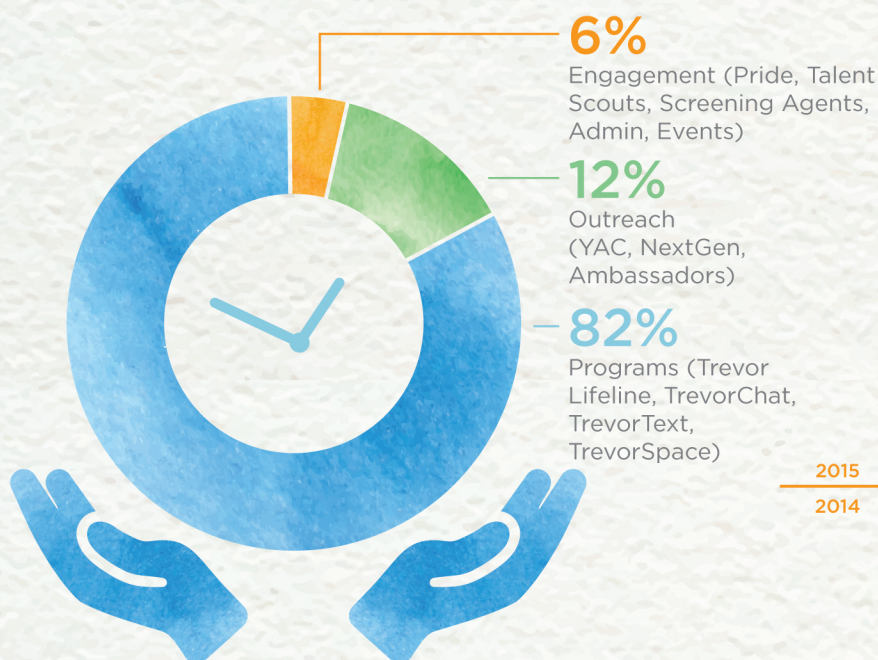
SEXUALITIES SERVED BY TREVORCHAT AND TREVORTEXT



VOLUNTEERS BY REGION

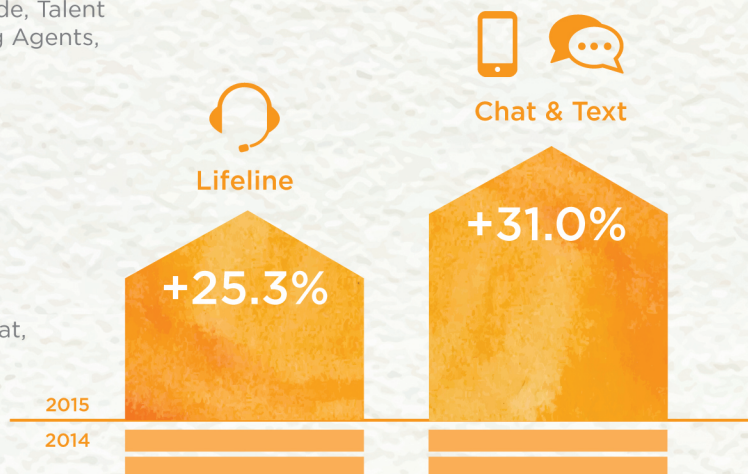

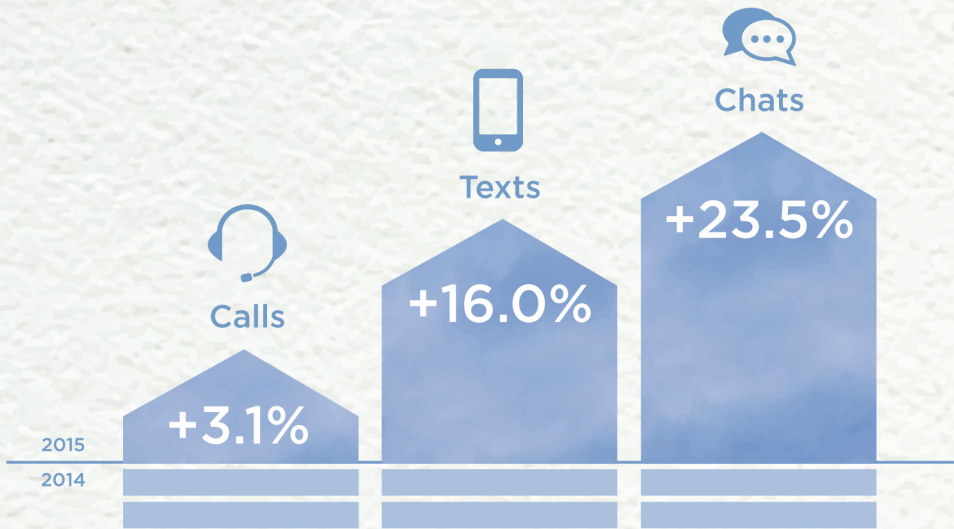

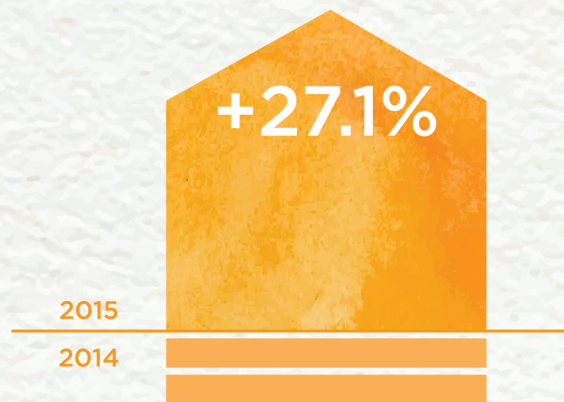


There was a 25.3% increase in Lifeline volunteers and a 31.0% increase in Chat and Text volunteers
